## **Grants Programme Aim**

To improve the quality of life of residents of the Borough of Bedford, through proactive, engaged and clearly defined grantmaking programmes and related activities which are responsive to current and emerging needs.



The Trust granted £124,250 to Faith in Queen's Park for their community projects



#### What we fund

- Activities that fall under our 3 charitable objects
  - Education
  - Recreation
  - Relief
- Activities benefiting people in the Borough of Bedford
- Mainly organisations
- Small number of grants to individuals (education)





#### What we don't fund

- Religious activities
- Commercial organisations
- Unlikely to make grants where there is a statutory duty to fund (increasingly grey area)





## **Application process**

- Phone us first to discuss idea (recent decisions & additional guidance)
- Two stage process
  - Preliminary Proposal for early guidance
  - Application Form
- One stage process for small applications
- On-line applications linked to Benefactor database
- Supporting documents

## **Decision making**

- Chair & Deputy –
   preliminary proposals and
   up to £5,000
- Full Committee up to £50,000 in any one year and £150,000 over a three year period
- Full Governors above £50,000 in any one year
